

Women Who Splice Program

Free, 3-day Training Program for Women in Nova Scotia

A free, 3-day, firsthand technical pilot program designed to introduce women to fiber optic splicing and telecommunications infrastructure careers in Nova Scotia, Canada and provide real-world field experience. This pilot program will provide realistic exposure to the technical and professional expectations of fiber optic splicing. Participants will leave with a clear understanding of whether this trade aligns with their skills and interests.

Program Structure

- Maximum six participants per cohort
- Introduction to fiber optic infrastructure and networks
- Firsthand cable preparation and fiber handling
- Fusion splicing demonstrations and supervised practice
- Overview of field environments and job site expectations
- Discussion of career pathways within telecom infrastructure

- This pilot does not guarantee employment
- Participants must be comfortable with hands-on technical work
- Work environments may involve kneeling, standing, working at heights, heavy lifting, and precision tasks.

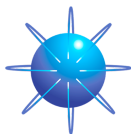
